

Customer Information German Battery Act - BattG

The Directive 2006/66/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council on batteries and accumulators and waste batteries and accumulators is the basis for placing batteries and accumulators on the market and for the disposal of spent batteries and accumulators.

The Directive was transposed into national law on 1st December 2009 by the Battery Act (BattG) with the amendment on 1st January 2021 on the marketing, return and environmentally sound disposal of batteries and accumulators.

Möhlenhoff GmbH declares that since the entry into force of the BattG, all batteries and accumulators used are exclusively purchased from manufacturers, importers and wholesalers who fully comply with their obligations under the Battery Act.

Thus, all requirements of the Battery Act are complied with by Möhlenhoff GmbH for the batteries and accumulators used.
